To us paid by **Elizabeth Ann Carlill**

DO HEREBY GRANT unto the said **Elizabeth Ann Carlill** His/her heirs and assigns, the exclusive Right of Burial in the double depth Ashes Grave Space **023** (was 3) In Block **Q** in the consecrated portion of the Ground at the **CEMETERY**, situate at **COMPTON** aforesaid, being part of the Burial Ground vested in the said Council, **TO HOLD** the same to the said **Elizabeth Ann Carlill** His/her heirs and assigns, for the purpose of Burial only, for a period not exceeding one hundred years from the date hereof, subject to any Regulation or Bye-laws now in force.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value, of the consideration exceeds thirty thousand pounds.
